35th Annual Mopar Spring Fling

This was my first time to attend the Mopar Spring Fling located in Van Nuys. Van Nuys is in the central San Fernando Valley region of Los Angeles. It is home to the Van Nuys airport and the Valley Municipal Building, and it is the most populous neighbourhood in the San Fernando Valley

The host for the show was the Chrysler Performance West So. Cal Car Club. The Spring Fling event was located at Woodley Park with access for the show located at 6350 Woodley Avenue, Van Nuys California.

This year's trip was made by Gary Keay, Mark Fletcher, Ray Myles and Brent and Kareen Stewart and me. The six of us headed South on April 10th and enjoyed three days of consistent driving to get to the main event (21 hours driving time) We then spent four days in that area.

Kareen elected to break away from the group midway through the state of Oregon as she had planned to visit with her aunt. Brent then hopped into Mark's car which already had Ray who was both navigating and helping with the driving.

Spring Fling activities started Thursday, at the Willow Springs International Raceway which is located at Rosamond, California, approximately 45 minutes from Woodley Park, in Van Nuys. The Raceway, founded in 1953, features substantial elevation changes and surprisingly high average speeds. The track is 2.5 miles long and includes nine turns. Willow Springs has become one of the fastest and most challenging tracks in the U.S.

After spending Thursday morning at the raceway, we continued onto the Airtel Plaza Hotel where we would spend the next four nights. The Hotel was approx. 5 minutes from Woodley Park.

As we headed for home we left under clear skies and enjoyed sunny weather all the way home except for a period of rain that was just north of Vancouver, Washington.

For me, this trip was highly informative and fully enjoyable. If any of you have a chance to go and take part in the Mopar Spring Fling in Van Nuys California I would strongly recommend it. It was a pleasant time, and the driving was not too taxing in that we tackled it in seven-hour stints per day and took breaks for food and gas.

Next year I hope to be taking my own car down and would love to be part of a group that heads down to Van Nuys again. Plan now to attend.


