Cabin Air Filters

Gary Burgess recently shared a bit of information on cabin air filters which may be of interest to our members. He recently had 3 incidents of people stating that the air in their vehicles was poor.

Two of them were visiting in relatively new vehicles from Alberta. Gary asked them if by chance they had changed their vehicle cabin air filter. In both cases they did not know they had a cabin air filter. Both of them were absolutely filthy with dust, leaves and dead bugs. They were in such bad shape they had to be replaced. The cost was about \$20.00 to \$30.00 each and took about 10 minutes to replace. Gary searched the internet on how to replace them for their specific vehicle.

It appears that they need to be changed about every one to two years, depending on the amount of accumulated dust and debris.

Interestingly enough, the shops they took their vehicles to for an oil change, did not check the cabin air filters nor did they ask if they needed to be checked.
